



Total Cases and Judgments

Judge Tigar was appointed to the bench on January 18, 2013. Since then this judge has been assigned 13 copyright cases. Of these, 8 cases have been terminated. There have been judgments in favor of a party (includes consent and default judgments) in 4 case(s). The plaintiff prevailed in 50.0% of these cases (while the defendant prevailed in 50.0% of these cases).




Number of Cases Decided, by Year


Contested Judgments

There have been 2 contested judgments in these cases (does not include consent and default judgments). The plaintiff prevailed in 0.0% of these cases, while the defendant prevailed in 100.0% of these cases. These figures are compared to the corresponding nationwide numbers below.



Time to Disposition-All Cases

The average time from case filing to case disposition by Judge Tigar is 10.7 months. The distribution of case terminations by month of litigation is shown below for the first 48 months of litigation. Time to Disposition-Cases with Judgments



Time to Disposition-Contested Judgments





Consent Judgment










